Establishment of a Sekisui Plastics Fund in Kanto Region, Japan to Support Environmental Contribution Activities

Sekisui Plastics Co., Ltd. (Head Office: 2-4-4 Nishitenma, Kita-ku, Osaka; President: Masato Kashiwabara) supports long-term environmental conservation activities developed by citizens. Also, Sekisui Plastics is managing a Sekisui Plastics Fund in the Kansai region for the purpose that our Group employees, as volunteers, support such activities. Recently, we have established a Sekisui Plastics Fund in the Kanto region in order to further enhance our support for the activities.

Staying true to our CSR declaration, "Sekisui Plastics Group – Expanding Our Dreams for People and the Earth," Sekisui Plastics Group is working to provide financial support to promote long-term environmental conservation activities developed by local citizens.

Also, with a view to contributing to society and assisting activities of supported organizations by participating in volunteer activities, we established a Sekisui Plastics Fund in "Mirai Fund Ohmi" managed by "Ohmi Network Center (Otsu city, Shiga prefecture)" in July 2012 and support forest preservation activities developed by "Association for Protecting Environment and Community Forest in Koga".

To develop our fund activities throughout Japan, we have recently established a Sekisui Plastics Fund in the Kanto region through donations to "Ibaraki Mirai Fund" managed by "Ibaraki NPO Center - Commons (Mito city, Ibaraki prefecture)".

In fiscal 2016, grant money was decided to provide for “Association for Protecting Community Forests in Koga”. The fund will be used to support environmental conservation activities in “Inamiya Forest / remains of Koga Castle moat (Koga city, Ibaraki prefecture)” as well as nature learning workshops for students from elementary and junior high schools.

Through the Sekisui Plastics Funds, we will further enhance our supports for environmental conservation activities, thereby promoting the volunteer efforts of our Group employees in the Kanto and Kansai regions.
