Although he was not aware of these facts until they came to light, he had regularly made recommendations concerning the company's ideal structure as a corporation and recommendations from the perspective of promoting compliance on several occasions including at the meetings of the Board of Directors of Kobe Steel, Ltd., and has drawn attention to these matters. Since these facts came to light, he has expressed several opinions at the meetings of the Board of Directors of Kobe Steel, Ltd. regarding the investigation into the causes of the inappropriate conduct, safety verification, and the adequateness and validity of investigation methods. Furthermore, as a member of the Quality Governance Restructuring Deliberation Committee, he contributed to the establishment of measures to prevent recurrence by proactively expressing constructive opinions concerning measures for strengthening quality governance of Group companies, organizational reforms, awareness reforms, and use of external talents, as well as reinforcement of the functions of overseas holding companies, based on his knowledge and experience.
